199 Years and Counting: In scanning the Spiceland Monthly Meeting records for the first few decades, one finds scarcely a season when someone wasn't brought up for some breach of the Discipline. The most frequent of these was marrying contrary to meeting regulations. Marrying "out of meeting" remained a grave offense for many years. When Samuel S. Painter (1820-1910) married Lucinda Forkner, a Methodist, August 18, 1842, he was visited by a committee of Friends who asked him if he couldn't say he was sorry he had married that woman. But he replied, "No, I wanted to do that more than anything else I ever did."
