199 Years and Counting: The log meetinghouse was erected in 1828. This building was replaced in 1833 with a frame structure, enlarged in 1839. In December, 1874, the frame meetinghouse was sold for \$125. Supposedly wood from the frame building was used in the construction of two homes on Academy Avenue.

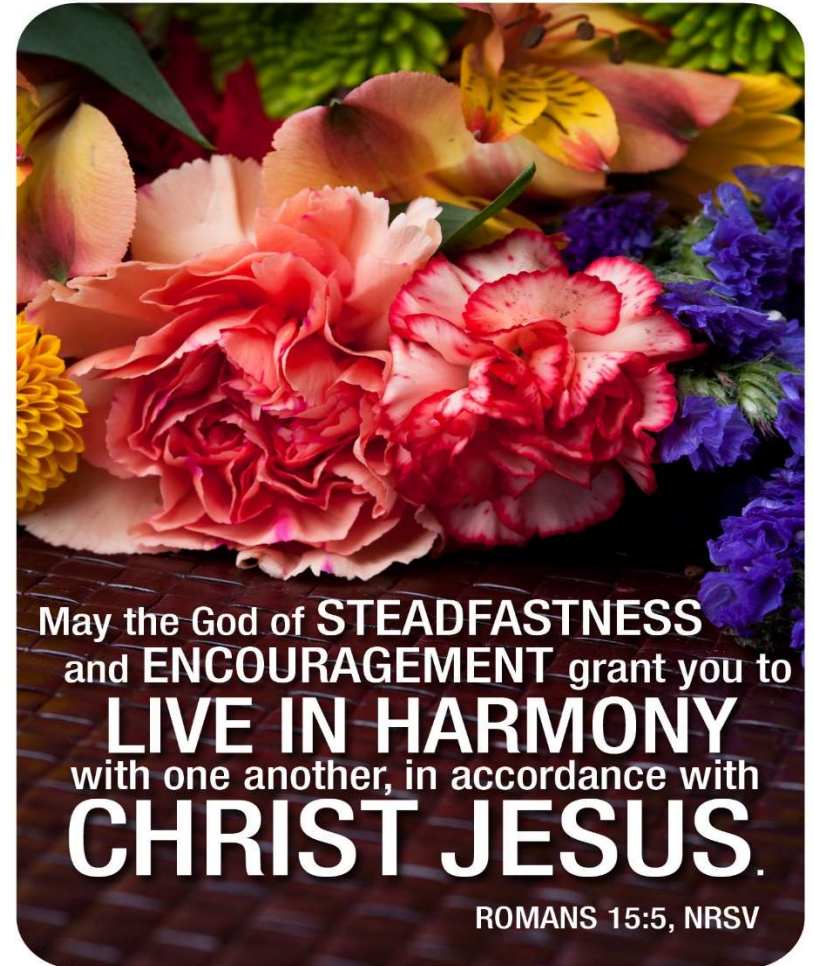
